- This is an application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of bail.
- 2. The applicant came to be arrested in Crime No. 64 of 2022 registered at Bhigwan Police Station, for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 323 r/w. 34 of Indian Penal Code.
- 3. I have heard the learned Counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the State.
- 4. According to the prosecution, on 12 March 2022, the present applicant and other co-accused assaulted the injured by iron rod, cricket bat and stumps on account of previous enmity and attempted to commit his murder.

- 5. I have perused the injury certificates. All the injuries are simple in nature.
- 6. The applicant is in jail for more than 1½ years. There are no other criminal antecedents. Considering the overall facts and circumstances, I am inclined to release the applicant on bail. Hence, the following order is passed:
- (i) Application is allowed.
- (ii) The applicant Vikram Balaso Madge be released on bail in Crime No. 64 of 2022 registered at Bhigwan Police Station, for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 323 r/w. 34 of Indian Penal Code, on furnishing P.R. Bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one or two sureties in the like amount.
- (iii) The applicant shall attend the concerned police station once in a month i.e., on first Saturday between 11.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. till conclusion of trial.
